Start Talking:

- 4) In Mark 9:35, Jesus told his disciples "Anyone who wants to be first must be the very last, and the servant of all." What would this look like in our lives? What might need to shift?
- 5) What is difficult about humbling ourselves to serve others?

- 1) What's a practical example of something in your life where you can flip the script – from chasing greatness to serving like Jesus?
- 2) Do you have margin in your life to serve others? If not, how could you create some?
- 3) Together, as a group write an individual and cooperate list of people and places you can serve.
